It is almost 20 years since Daniel Goleman first wrote about Emotional Intelligence. Now, it is widely accepted that while IQ might GET you a job, EQ will increase the likelihood that you will do it effectively. But is it enough? Do we need to go deeper? Cindy Wigglesworth has defined Spiritual Intelligence as “the ability to behave with wisdom and compassion, while maintaining inner and outer peace, regardless of the situation”. We all need this! But leaders especially need it. In this workshop, you will examine the spiritual self as one of the doorways to be an authentic leader.
